ORDER

WHEREAS, the existence and spread of COVID-19 has resulted in the declaration of a state of emergency by Governor Parsons; and,

WHEREAS, unless this Court takes action to recall all municipal warrants of the Overland Municipal Division, under §575.180 RSMo, any law enforcement officer within the state of Missouri may be subject to criminal prosecution for failing to execute the City of Overland's Municipal Division's arrest warrants; and,

WHEREAS, to protect the health safety and welfare of law enforcement, defendants and the citizens and employees of the City of Overland, Missouri, the court hereby determines that it is necessary to cancel all outstanding warrants and notify defendants of new court dates to be set at least 30 days from the date of this Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, effective Monday, March 16, 2020, that all municipal warrants for the City of Overland's Municipal Division are hereby ordered cancelled and all defendants currently in warrant status shall be assigned new court dates by the Court Clerk at least 30 days from the date of this Order.
