AMENDED ORDER


**WHEREAS**, the Missouri Supreme Court has suspended all in-person proceedings in all appellate and circuit courts – including all associate, family, juvenile, municipal and probate divisions, subject to certain narrow exceptions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Presiding Judge for the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit Court has entered an Administrative Order consistent with the Supreme Court’s order and directed all Municipal Courts within the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit to take appropriate actions consistent with the same.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, that, effective immediately:

1. Pending further direction from the Missouri Supreme Court and Presiding Judge for the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit, all municipal dockets for the City of Overland Municipal Division are **CANCELLED** and the Division’s dockets shall resume, consistent with the previously approved schedule, with the May 6, 2020 3:00 p.m. traffic docket, subject to the additional supplementary court dates approved by the undersigned.
2. The Municipal Division Court Clerk shall assign new court dates to all defendants and issue summons by mail for appearance.
3. All parties and attorneys having business before the Municipal Division are encouraged to communicate with the Court via the Clerk’s office via telephone, facsimile or mail to the maximum extent possible until such time as the suspension of in-person proceedings has been lifted. 4. This Order is subject to revision at any time and is entered into for the protection of the health and welfare of the citizens of Overland, the citizens of St. Louis County, all law enforcement officers, court staff, and defendants.
